Amendment 1

The main effect of this amendment is to change the classes and to subdivide the Laser class. There are consequential changes to flags, starting sequence and prizes.

The new text of each amended sailing instruction is given in full below.

S.I. 6 CLASSES, DIVISIONS and FLAGS

Laser class	Laser 1 boats, all rigs, subdivided as below		
	Radial division: Laser 1 with radial rig	G flag	
	Full Rig division: Laser 1 with full rig	Laser flag	
	4.7 division: Laser 1 with 4.7 rig	Laser flag	
PY class	All other boats	F flag	

S.I. 10 THE START

10.1 Races will be started using RRS 26, with the warning signal 3 minutes before the starting signal of each class, and the preparatory signal 2 minutes before the starting signal. This changes RRS 26. The normal start sequence for the first race is:

S.I. 16 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each class or division in each series. There will also be a prize for the best Junior in each series. Prizes for series 1 will be awarded, if possible, on Sunday 16 December 2018 at the Christmas party. Prizes for series 2 and for the overall series will be presented in the DMYC on 31 March 2019.

Special weekly prizes may also be presented after each day's racing (at approx. 1700 hours). These will normally be awarded to the boat with the best performance in each class, excluding boats that have already won such a prize. Competitors must be present to collect prizes on the day.
