

DMYC Frostbite Challenge For Mono-Hull Dinghies Sailing Instructions 2019-2020

Amendment 1

The effect of this amendment is to change the schedule of races on Sunday 23 February. It also allows for an alternative finish mark, to allow the start line for a subsequent race to be laid while boats are still finishing the previous race.

The new text of each amended sailing instruction is given in full below.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 13:57, except on 23 February 2020, when the warning signal for the first race will be at 12:57.

10 THE START

10.1 Races will be started using RRS 26, with the warning signal 3 minutes before the starting signal of each class, and the preparatory signal 2 minutes before the starting signal. This changes RRS 26. The normal start sequence for the first race is:

9 MARKS

The main rounding marks will be orange or yellow inflatable marks. The windward mark will be a cylindrical mark. The offset mark, if used, will be an orange or yellow mark, smaller than the windward mark and a different shape. The start mark will be a striped inflatable mark. The finish mark may be a striped inflatable mark or another recognisable mark laid close to the committee boat.
