NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Number 1: Race Committee Vessel

The race committee vessel will be a white motor launch "Goose".

Number 2: Commercial Traffic

All boats must keep clear of commercial traffic. On Saturday 23rd July, a cruise ship with 6 tenders is expected to anchor northeast of Dun Laoghaire harbour and will employ tenders to transport passengers to and from the ships. Each tender will have a RIB in attendance displaying a YELLOW FLAG mounted at the bow. RIBS will be operating on VHF Ch. 14. Boats must not impede the passage of Tenders and must not pass between RIB and Tender.

Number 3: Congestion in Dublin Bay on Saturday 23rd July

There will be at least five (5) other fleets racing on the bay after 14:00. Competitors are asked not to cross race courses of other fleets, especially dinghies, when not racing and not to cross the DBSC finish line off the West Pier Hut.

In order to set a course of championship standard, there may be a delay between races, depending on the location of other fleets. The race committee will broadcast updates on VHF.

It may be necessary to change VHF channel; any change of channel will be displayed on the race committee vessel in accordance with SI 22.2.
