International 12 foot Dinghy and Dublin Bay 12 foot Dinghy Irish Championship

NOTICE OF RACE

2 November 2025

1. Rules

The event will be sailed under the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-28, the prescriptions of Irish Sailing, the class rules and this Notice of Race except as modified by the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.

The Organising Authority will be the Dun Laoghaire Motor Yacht Club (DMYC).

2. Eligibility and Insurance

The event is open to all International 12 foot class dinghies and Dublin Bay 12 foot dinghies. Each boat may be crewed by one or two people.

Each participating boat must have third-party insurance cover of not less than €3.0 million.

3. Location

The races will probably take place inside Dun Laoghaire Harbour, but racing may be in Dublin Bay, close to the harbour.

4. Courses

The courses will be either windward-leeward, triangular or a modified Olympic triangle. Details will be in the Sailing Instructions.

5. Schedule

Racing is scheduled on Sunday 2 November 2025, in conjunction with the Viking Marine Frostbite Series. There will be a briefing for competitors in the Coal Harbour boat yard at 11:45.

The aim will be to provide two races, with a maximum of three races. The first start for 12 foot dinghies is scheduled for 14:09 local time. (This will follow starts for boats competing in the Frostbite Series.) The second race (and possible third race) will follow the completion of the previous race.

If the wind speed exceeds 15 kt, racing will be postponed or abandoned.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available on the DMYC web site (www.dmyc.ie) no later than 29 October. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will also be published on the web site.

7. Entry

An online entry form is available at <u>www.dmyc.ie</u>. Entries must be received before 20:00 on Saturday 1 November. The entry fee is €15.

8. Scoring

The low points scoring system of RRS appendix A will be used.

At least one race must be completed to constitute the championship. If three races have been completed, one discard will be allowed.

9. Prizes

Perpetual trophies may be awarded: probably the Seapoint Trophy and the Cora Cup.

Prizes will be presented in the DMYC after racing, at approximately 17:00. Competitors and their guests will be deemed temporary members of the DMYC on the day of the event.

10. Data Protection

The personal information that you provide to DMYC on the entry form will be used only to facilitate your participation in this event and will be deleted after the event. The results may be published online, including the names of competitors.
